We have added a radio link from K7SWF to K7LHC repeater so that members that are out of the area will be able to use the repeater to contact hams in the area, check in to our Tuesday 2m net.

In order to use this link, you will have to install Echolink software from Echolink.org, email a copy of your current license to prove you are a licensed amateur radio operator. You will receive an email back letting you know that you can go to Validation on their website to finish the connection.

Once this is all done, open Echolink, go to the US Repeater listing and find K7SWF-R. Once found right click and add to Favorites so you don't have to keep looking it up.

When ready to login to the Net, click on K7SWF-R and connect. Once connected, you will be able to transmit and receive on the K7LHC repeater as if you were here in the Flesh.
